2016 Rally America National Championship Calendar and License Fees

Overview:

1. The 2016 Rally America National Championship shall consist of eight events:
 - Round #1: Sno*Drift Rally, January 29 – 30
 - Round #2: Rally in the 100 Acre Wood, March 18 – 19
 - Round #3: Oregon Trail Rally, April 22 – 24
 - Round #4: Olympus Rally, May 14 – 15
 - Round #5: Susquehannock Trail Performance Rally, June 3 – 4
 - Round #6: New England Forest Rally, July 15 – 16
 - Round #7: Ojibwe Forests Rally, August 26 – 27
 - Round #8: Lake Superior Performance Rally, October 14 – 15
2. Replace Article 9.1.B with the following:
 - B. This year there are no “mandatory” events.

All rounds on the National Championship calendar will be counted equally toward the Championship.
3. Replace Article 2.1.D.1 with the following.
 1. The fees for a Regional License are as follows.
 - i. Except as described below, the fee for a Regional License is ~~\$235~~ \$150.
 - ii. ~~The fee for upgrading a valid USAC Rally License to a Rally America Regional License is \$25.~~
 - iii. The fee for a Regional License for a Canadian resident who holds a valid CARS license is \$75 per event.
 - iv. The fee for a Single-Event Regional License is ~~\$150~~ \$75. The single-event License may be upgraded to an annual license at

the competitor's second event for the season for ~~\$85~~ \$100.

v. The additional license fee for Dual Entry (single event) is \$75.

4. Replace Article 2.1.E.1 with the following.

1. The fees for a National Rally License are as follows.

a. The fee for a National License is ~~\$295~~ \$300.

b. The fee for upgrading a valid USAC rally license to a Rally America National License is \$175.

c. The fee for a Single-Event National License is \$150. The single-event License may be upgraded to an annual license at the competitor's second event for the season for ~~\$145~~ \$200. Otherwise, there is no single-event National Rally License.

There is no credit for mid-season upgrades from any Regional License to a National License.

5. Add the following section to Article 9.1.A.

5. National Limited Open

Competitors entered in National Limited Open Class will be scored in the National Limited Open National Championship.
