



Bulletin #9a 14-July-05

Subject: Claims against legality of a competition vehicle. This Bulletin amends rule 8.3.D.

Overview:

The rules, as written, stipulate that claims against the legality of a competition vehicle must be lodged before the first car leaves the first time control. This stipulation is suspended.

It is the intention of Rally America to inspect the cars for safety compliance, including but not limited to, weight and restrictor size prior to the event.

A claim (protest) against the legality of a competition vehicle shall be lodged no later than the protester's arrival at the final time control (MTC) of the event.

At the end of each event the competition vehicles will all be held in Parc Ferme until the last car arrives at Parc Ferme. Vehicles against which there are claims shall be held until the claims are resolved.

Stewards may interpret this bulletin as necessary to resolve penalties or protests.
