Subject:

Catalytic converter check and rules cleanup

Overview:

Effective immediately, the following rule changes go into effect:

1. Replace the first paragraph of Article 10.1.F with the following:
 - F. For all vehicles in all classes for all Performance Rally events, a functional catalytic converter shall be installed. Functionality shall be determined by ~~the following: 1) a visible and complete grid within the catalytic converter, or 2) a heat gain of 5% or greater from the inlet to the outlet of the cat with the outlet being hotter.~~

Rationale:

It is too easy to fake the heat difference check, so it is being eliminated.

2. Replace Article 10.2.B.6 with the following:

6. Production Category vehicles with forced induction shall have air inlet restriction as per Article 10.1.G.

Rationale:

Article 10.2.B.6 included redundant and potentially incorrect information, so it is being changed to refer to the general rule on air inlet restriction.
